

Cancellations, Collection and Punctuality

We are committed to offering our families a high quality option when choosing before and after school club care. We are based in the school dining room.

We provide:

- * Breakfast club from 7.30am to 8.45am, we will then take your child to their class.
- * After school provision from 3.30pm to 6.00pm.
- * Care for children from 3 to 11 years of age.
- * A safe, caring and stimulating environment with qualified and experienced staff.
- * Active fun and relaxation, making the most of our indoor and outdoor space.
- * Healthy breakfasts and snacks (all dietary needs met).

To join:

- * Complete a booking form, a registration form, and an emergency medical treatment form.
- Sign the Code of Conduct. We expect considerate behaviour to all staff at all times.
- * Pay the required fees by the required date every term.

All forms are available from the office or the club.



Appropriate staffing depends on the number of children we cater for. This is calculated on a term by term basis. Therefore we are unable to give refunds within a paid half term, unless there are exceptional circumstances. If possible, places should be booked for the coming half term. Unfortunately we are unable to give refunds should your child be absent.

We are also able to cater for children on an "ad hoc basis", but please provide 24 hours notice if possible. If someone not known to us is going to collect your child, please let us know as soon as possible, and a security password will be arranged.

If you are late collecting your child, some charges may apply.
