

Y1 – What can we do with money?

British values: Respect, Individual liberty

Knowledge

- what money is - that money comes in different forms
- how money is obtained (e.g. earned, won, borrowed, presents)
- how people make choices about what to do with money, including spending and saving
- the difference between needs and wants - that people may not always be able to have the things they want
- how to keep money safe and the different ways of doing this

Social and emotional skills

- Can identify things they *need* and how money provides this
- Can identify ways to spend/save money.

Key questions

- How can we get money?
- How can you keep your money safe?
- What are the different things you could do with money?
