<u>English</u>

Children will be continuing to develop their Reading and Writing skills, writing in a range of styles as well as reading challenging fiction texts as a stimulus for their writing. We will concentrate on writing in different genres, choosing where and when to use the correct vocabulary, punctuation and grammatical features to create the desired purpose and impact for the reader.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, children will be continuing to develop their arithmetic and fluency, whilst also continuing the skills detailed in the National Curriculum. Every lesson will see the children applying their new knowledge to reasoning and problem solving questions. They will also be undertaking a Maths-based project.
