Dear Year 4 Parents and Carers

I am extremely pleased to share with you our school's success in securing tickets to experience the joy and pleasure of listening to a live orchestral performance in the city's largest cultural venue – The Halls, Wolverhampton.

Competing with schools across the city, we have been allocated free tickets for the event on Tuesday 6th February 2024. The concert will provide an opportunity not only to visit the newly refurbished venue, but to also experience a live orchestra performing such classic pieces as; 'Spring' from the 'Four Seasons' (Vivaldi); 'Symphony No 5' (Beethoven); Super Mario main theme 'Overworld'; 'Jai Ho' from Slumdog Millionaire and the Symphonic Suite from 'How to train your Dragon' by John Powell.... plus many more.

The concert starts at 1.15pm but we have been given an arrival time of 12:45pm. This is to provide time for the arrival and seating of the 800 seated audience.

Given the school's proximity to the City Centre, we will walk to The Halls, Wolverhampton and will be departing at approximately 12.00pm. In anticipation of the departure time, children will have lunch at 11.30am. Normal lunch time arrangements will apply. School uniform must also be worn.

Attending the live orchestral performance of one hour's duration – the children will be presented with a printed programme including timelines, factual information, video links to performers and listening guides.

This is an exciting Cultural Capital experience for our Year 4 children and therefore, I hope you will share your consent and approval for your child's participation in this event.
