

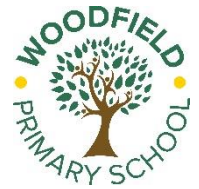

Dear Parents

Welcome back to our summer term here at Woodfield, and I hope that all of you managed to get some time to relax and enjoy the holiday. It is a wonderful time of year, where the children can go on the field for their break times, and we can do lots of outdoor learning and activities. Everything seems a little better when the sun is shining.

I would like to give you a couple of reminders for the summer term. Firstly, that we do pay for parking facilities over at Woodfield Social Club, and we would appreciate you using this car park. It is dangerous to stop outside school and, as I have said before, it is one of my biggest fears that a child will be hit by a car. There were a couple of near misses last term, mainly because people were in a hurry, or they were doing 3 point turns outside school. We don't mind if you are a few minutes late occasionally to pick your child up!
