

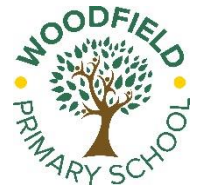

learning at this time, and some children are missing significant parts of lessons as they are arriving late. Let me know if you are having difficulty getting here on time and we can try to help.

Please look out for a survey about physical activity that we will be sending you via text. We want to get some information about the sorts of things your children do in (and out) of school, as this will help us to organise clubs for the children next term and beyond (whether from in school or outside providers). The survey will take you two minutes and we would appreciate as many people as possible filling it in.

Finally, we are very lucky in that we have been approached by a charity to help them distribute free food. They are a charity that aims to reduce food waste and they are working with Tesco. Subsequently, **every Thursday, at 2.45pm on the infant playground**, we will set up a stall where you can take food that is nearly past its sell by date. This is for everyone, there is no charge for the food and we would be delighted if we could make this a regular thing. I strongly advise you to get there before I do, though, as if there are any crisps or biscuits I will have them in no time.
